Upon your arrival, you can expect to enter a clean and sparkling cabin. Please make yourself at home. We have tried to make it as comfortable as possible. There will be an initial supply of toilet paper and paper towels. We have a pretty good assortment of books for your reading pleasure. We have many different sizes of pots and pans for the chef in the family so no worries about not having kitchenware to cook with. Come relax and re-energize!

**KEY TO THE CABIN:** There is a lock box affixed to the stair support which is under the carport. Upon arrival, park under the carport. The key lock box will be in front of you on the stair support. **The code to unlock the box is "5419".** Simply align the numbers then pull down on the black lever. In addition, there will be a spare key to the cabin hung on the Eat, Sleep and Fish key rack inside on the right when you come in the door from the carport next to the window on the right. When you check out, please put the cabin key (one with the red band) back in the key box and lock it.

The Cabin is located in Blue Ridge which is in Fannin County but we are on the Cherry Log mail route coming out of Gilmer County to our South. Thus the address for the cabin is a Cherry Log address.

Pets: Please be aware that <u>ABSOLUTELY NO PETS</u> are allowed at the cabin.

**Smoking:** No smoking is allowed inside the cabin. However, we have provided 3 cylinder type cigarette butt receptacles in different places around the cabin. You will find one at the base of the stairs going into the utility room affixed to the carport post next to where the wood is stacked. There is also one affixed to the staircase post of the stairs coming down from the enclosed porch. Lastly, there is one affixed to the gazebo on the pond side. Please be respectful and use the receptacles provided.

**Long Distance Calls:** Long distance calls are prohibited. If you need to make a long distance call please use a calling card.

**Sleeping arrangement:** There is a King bed in the Master, a King bed in the loft, a queen futon (with a very nice mattress) on the enclosed porch and one set of twin bunk beds in the bunk room.

**TV:** There is a 47" flat screen TV with a sound bar in the main living area and a 32" flat screen TV in the Master bedroom\*\*\* Please do not add to or change any settings on the TV programming.

**Central Heat and Air:** The cabin has a gas furnace for central heating and a central air conditioner for cooling. The thermostat is on the wall under the stairs. Please be cognizant about keeping windows and doors closed while the heater or air conditioner is running.

**Back-up Heat:** In case the power goes out, there is a secondary heating unit. The gas space heater is in the main living area. If power fully goes out to the cabin and there is a need to use the space heater, please pull the space heater away from the wall/ side of the refrigerator by about 6 inches. The space heater puts out a lot of heat and if not moved away from the refrigerator, it will cause the refrigerator to overheat.

**Fireplace:** \*\*\* (*FIREPLACE ONLY TO BE USED OCTOBER THRU APRIL*)\*\*\* When using fireplace, please make sure the flue is open before lighting a fire. Also, the ceiling fan in the living room will need to be off and the windows will need to be closed. If these things are not done, smoke will be pushed from the fireplace and in to the cabin. It is all about the flow of air.

When the fireplace is not in use, please close the flue to keep the cabin warm. If the flue is not closed when there is no fire, the heat from the cabin will be sucked out of the chimney. \*\*\*\*\*You might want to purchase lighter knot/fatwood for ease of starting the fire\*\*\*\*

**Trash:** All trash must be bagged. We supply trash bags. Please deposit trash in the outside trash cans underneath the staircase going into the Utility room. It is the staircase under the carport. Please be sure to keep the door closed on the enclosure. We don't want Smokey the bear to get in the trash during the night. Trash is picked up from the cabin on Fridays. There are many trash cans under the deck so there will be an empty one for you.

**Power Outages:** Power outages are very rare but we want to make our guests aware if by chance the power does go out. If the power goes out in just part of the cabin, then this would signify that something has tripped most likely because of a power surge from the electric company. There are several GFI (Ground Fault Interrupter) receptacles throughout the cabin for safety reasons. If by chance there is a partial outage, go around to the receptacles and hit the reset buttons. This should restore the power to the area of the cabin which lost power.

If there is ever a case where the power completely goes out, the power company is extremely proactive about getting the power back on in short order. Generally it will be a tree limb falling and hitting a power line.

**Outside Propane Grill:** Please keep the grill covered when not in use. There are three propane tanks so if you run out simply replace the empty one with the full one. If you run out of propane, the extra bottles of propane are in the enclosed area under the staircase going in to the Utility room where the garbage cans are kept. This is the staircase under the carport. We ask that if a tank runs out, please set it on the carport next to the staircase so that housekeeper will know to get a replacement for our next guests.

**Fire pit Firewood:** As part of the reservation process, firewood for the fire pit is a mandatory purchase. We started the mandatory charge for the firewood because the guests who didn't pay for the firewood upfront, would want to pay once they got to the cabin and saw the fire pit firsthand. It is much cheaper for the guest to pay the charge than to buy the firewood from the store. If for some reason, you are absolutely sure that you will not have a desire for the firewood, please let us know in advance and the fee can be deducted from the cost of your stay.

**Fire pit:** \*\*\* ( IF YOU DID NOT PAY FOR FIREWOOD AS PART OF YOUR RESERVATION, PLEASE DO NOT USE THE FIREWOOD AT THE CABIN) \*\*\* If you have paid the fee for wood to be used in the fire pit, the wood will be under the carport. You will also find skewers hanging underneath the porch next to the center post for use when cooking in the fire pit. Please wash and return the skewers to the hooks after each use. \*\*\*\*\*You might want to purchase lighter knot/fatwood for ease of starting the fire\*\*\*\*

#### **Initial Supplies**

The cabin will be stocked with an initial supply of toilet paper, trash bags, dish washing soap, dishwasher soap and bath soap. The kitchen is fully stocked with utensils. Don't forget to bring or pick up extra paper towels, toilet paper, laundry detergent, and coffee filters. It would not be good to run out of any of these. There are several major food stores in the area, such as Ingles & Food Lion in Blue Ridge and Walmart in Blue Ridge and Ellijay.

### **Upon Departure:**

- Place all dirty dishes in the dishwasher
- Lock all doors and windows
- Close Flue on fireplace
- Turn off all lights
- Hang cabin key on the Eat, Sleep and Fish key rack
- Place cabin key with red band back in the lockbox and close

### THINGS TO DO

**Fishing:** The Walmart Supercenters in Blue Ridge and Ellijay sell live worms. If you will be fishing in the pond, the worms will work well for you. If you filet any fish, please dispose of the remains back in to the pond. We do not want bears coming around the cabin looking for food. When fishing in the pond, please fish in front of the cabin and to the left when facing the pond. As there are other cabins in the area, we want to be respectful of their waterfront. Please be sure not to leave anything around the banks of the pond. We keep a very clean area and want to make sure it stays that way for all of our guests. If you are a smoker, please use the cylindrical cigarette receptacle affixed to the gazebo on the pond side to deposit cigarette butts.

**Walking Trail:** To go for a really nice walk, you can do so right from the cabin. On the directional map provided, if you were to keep going straight on Cashes Valley Road (where the small flow of water comes across the road) instead of turning left on to Oliver's Trail when coming to the cabin, you can walk for several miles back in to the forest on Cashes Valley Road by going straight up the hill after going over the water. You will actually cross over the creek several times along the way. The road follows the creek.
